Some adjustments may have to be made on the day to ensure we have an EDM operator available on both long throws. If insufficient officials are available to meet UKA licensing requirements, Track or Field events may be cancelled by the Meeting Secretary following discussion with the appropriate Referee.

“A” level clubs (av > 25 athletes): - Blackburn, Blackpool, LPS and Preston

“B” level clubs (av 16 – 25 athletes): - L&M, Pendle and Southport Waterloo

“C” level clubs (av 6 – 15 athletes): - Barrow, Burnley, Chorley, Hyndburn and Kirkby Milers

“D” level clubs (av 4-5 athletes): - Lytham St Annes

“E” level clubs (av 3 or less athletes): - Carlisle Aspatria and Glaxo Hoad Hill

“A” size clubs to provide 5 officials, 2\* of which must be graded to minimum level 2

“B” size clubs to provide 4 officials, 2\* of which must be graded to minimum level 2

\* At least 1 of the graded officials required should be qualified in a track discipline.

“C” size clubs to provide 3 officials, 1 of which must be graded to minimum level 2

“D” size clubs to provide 2 officials, 1 of which must be graded to minimum level 2

“E” size clubs do not need to provide any officials

Club sizes will be reviewed at the end of the season and any changes will be notified at the AGM to take effect in the following season. Information from the previous 2 seasons will be used.

Failure to provide the required number and level of officials at more than one of the six meetings will result in the club involved being fined £30 for every missing graded official and £10 for every missing ungraded official.
