**MID LANCS LEAGUE:

The Annual General Meeting and the annual Track & Field Fixtures Meeting of the Mid Lancs League will be held at the Lansil Sports Club, Caton Rd, Lancaster, Lancashire, LA1 3PE, on Wednesday 29th November 2017, commencing promptly at 7.30 pm.

13. Review of Junior hurdles trial in 2016.
14. Proposal to clarify the Rule on guests
That Rule 21 should read: (proposed changes underlined)

21 Guests can compete in Mid Lancs track & field fixtures, including the Medal Meeting, on payment of an entry fee per event. Guests are taken to be members of clubs affiliated to England Athletics who are not members of the Mid Lancs Track & Field League. Guests will not qualify for a medal at the Medal Meeting. Competition Rules apply to guests as they apply generally.
