CLAYTON HARRIERS WIN AT LANCASTER.

Seven teams competed in the Mid-Lancashire Cross-Country League race at Lancaster on Saturday. The course of seven-and-a-half miles commenced at the Primrose Harriers headquarters and lay over the high ground in the Langhwaite district. W. H. Rispin, of Blackpool and Fylde Harriers, was the first man to finish, with Walker, of Clayton Harriers, second, and Casey, of Lancaster H. and A.C., third. The results were: Clayton Harriers 57 pts., Blackpool Harriers 58 pts., Lancaster H. and A.C. 81 pts., and Lancaster Primrose Harriers 132 pts. Other competing teams were Leyland Motors A.C., R.A.F. Weeton, and R.A.F. Kirkham.
